Street Outreach: Teams go directly into high-need areas to find people who are lost or suffering.

Physical Aid: Volunteers hand out free food and donated clothes to meet immediate survival needs.

Spiritual Support: Members pray with individuals on the street and invite them to local bible studies or church gatherings.

Recovery Referrals: The group connects men and women to professional detox centers and supportive Christian discipleship homes.
